

Foundation Stage Two Autumn Two 'Tales and Toys, Old and New'

Literacy
In literacy we will use the Talk for Writing method and learn the story 'The Gingerbread Man' as a class, later innovating the story using the same story language but changing the characters. We will look at toys from the past and compare these to some of our favourite, writing about these as a class and independently. We will continue to develop our phonic knowledge learning to recognise and write the letters of the alphabet as well as some simple phonetically decodable words. <u>Key Vocabulary</u> Once upon a time, Then, After that, The end.
Physical Development
In PE we will be developing our balance and coordination. During our P.E session, we will be learning a range of games to develop our footwork skills. Whilst in our classroom and outdoor provision, we will be joining in with a range of activities to develop our gross and fine motor skills. Each day we will take part in a Dough Disco session to help us to develop our fine motor skills.
<u>Understanding the World</u> This half term we will learn about Diwali and how the Festival of Light is celebrated. We will make Rangoli patterns and diva lamps using clay. We will also learn more about Christmas and how this is celebrated. We will look at toys from the past and compare these to our favourite toys, discussing how toys have changed
over time.
